

The experiences in other wineries of both José Félix (Petrus – France, 1999; Torres – Chile, 2000) and Noelia (Araujo – Napa, 2007 and 2010; Cobos – Mendoza, 2008) have provided the basis for further developing a philosophy dump on the soil and to be *Vignerons.*

Our landscape is located in the village of *Sotillo de la Ribera*, province of Burgos, on the northern edge of the Duero river basin, in a privileged environment, due to its high **altitude (830 - 930 m)**, where the moors (*páramo*) of the highest areas, with limestone soils, give way as we follow the erosion of the valley, to gravel soils (old river beds), sandy areas in the pine area, and clays in the lower areas .

## terroir

VINEYARDS

- Selection of **Albillo Mayor** from our vineyard: *El Lebrero and La Virgen.*
- Tipe of soil: clay loam and sandy-limestone.
- Altitude: 920 m. and 880 m.
- Yield: 2,0 kg/ha.
- Manual picking in boxes of 12 kilos capacity with two sorting tables; Gravity system.

- José Félix y Noelia Callejo Winemakers
- (1/3) Maceration and fermented with skins in stainless steel.
- (2/3) Fermented in fûts 500 L and concrete egg.
- Natural yeast.
- Aging: 8 months in contact with lees in concrete egg and fûts 500 L.
- # Bottles: 8,960.
- # Magnum: 20.

### Vintage 2021 INFORMATION

The 2021 vintage is characterized by regular temperatures and rainfall throughout the cycle in the vineyard. It can be considered typical in our area. The period from October 2020 to September 2021 had rainfall of 450 mm, well distributed in winter and spring, in such a way that the vineyard was able to endure the summer with hardly any rain.

Temperatures that are not excessively cold in winter, causes an advance of more than 10 days in budbreak and consequently the cycle is advanced until harvest.

We begin the harvest on September 23 with Albillo Mayor, followed by Tinto Fino and Garnacha.

The quality and health of the grape is exceptional, being able to produce wines with great finesse and character.
